- DO NOT CHARGE BATTERY IN EXTREME CONDITIONS. Battery should be charged in a location where temperature is more than 50°F and less than 100°F.
- Under extreme usage or temperature conditions, battery leakage may occur. If liquid comes in contact with your skin, wash immediately with soap and water, then neutralize with lemon juice or vinegar. 

POD INSTALLATION


- 1. Match your unit up to one of the drawings to decide which set of POD Brackets to use.
- 2. Attach POD Brackets (#2) to top of POD using four screws (#3), lockwashers (#4) and washers (#5). Tighten screws tight. See Figure 2.





- **3.** Lower system until Board Arms rest on safety stops. See Figure 3.
- 4. If Actuator Handle is attached to actuator remove pull pin and then remove Actuator Handle. NOTE: Put Actuator Handle in a safe place. It may be needed if adjustment is necessary while battery is charging.
- **5.** Loosen, **DO NOT REMOVE**, bolts securing actuator to post ears. See Figure 4.
- **6.** Slide POD brackets between flatwasher and plastic washer. Secure POD Coupler to actuator by inserting Pull Pin (#5). See Figure 4.
- 7. Tighten bolts securing Actuator tight.

OPERATION

Unit Operation

Push on the bottom of the Up/Down switch to lower the unit. Push on the top of the Up/Down switch to raise the unit.

IMPORTANT! Do not adjust unit above 10 feet or below 7-1/2 feet. Adjusting height outside of this range may damage unit.

If your unit stops working suddenly check fuse located in switch panel. If necessary replace fuse with a 7 amp fuse. Using a fuse other than a 7 amp fuse can result in damage to your system and will void your warranty.


To prevent unwanted use of your POD system keep access door locked at all times.

Charging Battery

IMPORTANT! Do not store batteries in discharged state. Recharge batteries after every 30 cycles.

- 1. Pull battery out of battery compartment.
- 2. Unplug battery connector from POD.

IMPORTANT! Do NOT store battery in POD during cold weather. Store batteries near room temperature in a dry place.



IMPORTANT! Make sure power supply is normal house voltage, 120 volts, 60Hz, AC only.

- 3. Plug battery into charger. Red light should turn on. If green light turns on, battery is already charged.
- 4. Allow battery to charge until green light on charger turns on.

IMPORTANT! Do NOT continue charging after green light turns on. Charge cycle is approximately 10 hours. Charge cycle varies depending on extent of charge left in battery.

LIMITED WARRANTY

Subject to proper installation and normal use, Escalade Sports warrants, subject to the limitations below, to the original retail purchaser all components of the POD System to be free of defects in material and workmanship for the period of one year from the date of purchase by the original retail purchaser.

Merchandise must be shipped prepaid with a copy of proof of purchase to our factory for examination to see whether it needs to be repaired or replaced. Any labor costs, travel expenses and any other changes involved in the removal, installation or replacement of the defective/repaired parts from/to your POD System will be your (the purchaser's) responsibility. Shipping charges for replaced or warranted merchandise being sent back to the customer from our factory must be prepaid by the customer in advance. If not, the replacement shipment will be sent out collect.
